9	Relating to courts; to amend Section 12-19-210, Code of
10	Alabama 1975, to increase the expense allowance and mileage
11	reimbursement paid to jurors by order or rule.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. Section 12-19-210, Code of Alabama 1975, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	"§12-19-210
16	(a) Regular jurors, grand and petit, shall be entitled
17	to \$10.00 <u>an</u> expense allowance for each day's services, \$.05
18	for each and an amount for each mile traveled in going to and
19	returning from court and ferriage and toll, to be proved by
20	the oath of the juror before the clerk of the court. $\frac{The \ clerk}{The \ clerk}$
21	shall give each juror a certificate, stating therein the
22	number of days he has served, the number of miles he has
23	traveled, the amount of ferriage and toll he has paid and the
24	amount of expense allowance to which he is entitled.
25	(b) The Alabama Supreme Court, by order or rule, shall
26	establish the amount of expense allowance and mileage to be
27	paid to each juror.
28	(c) The certificate monies paid shall be payable out of



29	the State Treasury from funds appropriated to the
30	Administrative Office of Courts by the Legislature.
31	(b) The provisions of this section shall be retroactive
32	to May 23, 1977."
33	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
34	day of the third month following its passage and approval by
35	the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
