1 Enrolled, An Act,

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3 Relating to courts; to amend Section 12-19-210, Code of
4 Alabama 1975, to increase the expense allowance and mileage
5 reimbursement paid to jurors by order or rule.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. Section 12-19-210, Code of Alabama 1975, is
8 amended to read as follows:

9 "§12-19-210

10 (a) Regular jurors, grand and petit, shall be entitled
11 to ~~\$10.00~~ an expense allowance for each day's services, ~~\$.05~~
12 ~~for each~~ and an amount for each mile traveled in going to and
13 returning from court ~~and ferriage and toll~~, to be proved by
14 the oath of the juror before the clerk of the court. ~~The clerk~~
15 ~~shall give each juror a certificate, stating therein the~~
16 ~~number of days he has served, the number of miles he has~~
17 ~~traveled, the amount of ferriage and toll he has paid and the~~
18 ~~amount of expense allowance to which he is entitled.~~

19 (b) The Alabama Supreme Court, by order or rule, shall
20 establish the amount of expense allowance and mileage to be
21 paid to each juror.

22 (c) The ~~certificate monies paid~~ shall be payable out of
23 the State Treasury from funds appropriated to the
24 Administrative Office of Courts by the Legislature.

25 ~~(b) The provisions of this section shall be retroactive~~
26 ~~to May 23, 1977."~~

27 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
28 day of the third month following its passage and approval by



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29 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
