There is no fee for the permit. Upon application, there shall be a one-time, nonrefundable filing fee of fifty dollars (\$50), in addition to a permit fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150), which shall be renewed annually. The one-time filing fee shall apply only to new applicants for a permit on or after the effective date of the act

(2) The fees collected under this subsection shall be distributed as follows: a. Seventy-five percent shall be deposited into the Tobacco Licensing and Compliance Fund to be used for operational costs of enforcing this chapter and

tobacco and nicotine prevention education.
