28	Emmanuel Vincent; for the next many years, various other
29	leader figures were ordained in the church; and
30	WHEREAS, the Church of Christ has been involved with
31	many outreach programs to bring Good's Word to the community
32	and to serve its physical needs as well, including, but not
33	limited to, Community Awareness Education Forums on
34	Wednesday nights, yearly free household goods and clothing
35	drives to the community, and food insecurity distribution;
36	the congregation has also supported water and food supply
37	drives for disaster victims in and outside the area,
38	including Texas, Tennessee, Louisiana, and Michigan; the
39	church's Blue Spring Road Academy Pre-School and Child
