| 13 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:                            |
| 14 | Section 1. (a) For a period commencing October 1, 2024,                 |
| 15 | and ending September 30, 2029, up to twenty-five thousand               |
| 16 | dollars (\$25,000) of the gross proceeds from the sale of               |
| 17 | fencing materials such as t-posts, wood posts, barbed wire,             |
| 18 | net wire, smooth wire, standard metal gates, and other like             |
| 19 | materials used for the purpose of fencing in agriculture                |
| 20 | livestock applications are exempt from the sales and use tax            |
| 21 | as provided for in Section <mark>s</mark> 40-23-2 and 40-23-61, Code of |
| 22 | Alabama 1975. The exemption provided in this subdivision shall          |
| 23 | not apply to county or municipal sales and use taxes unless             |
| 24 | approved by resolution or ordinance adopted by the local                |
| 25 | governing body.   |
| 26 | (b) To qualify for the exemption, a retail purchaser                    |
| 27 | shall provide to a seller an affidavit confirming the                   |
| 28 | purchased material is strictly for an agriculture livestock             |

- application. The affidavit shall relieve the seller of the
- obligation to collect the tax under Chapter 23 of Title 40,
- 31 Code of Alabama 1975, with respect to the sale of such
- 32 materials. The Department of Revenue shall make the affidavit
- available to sellers.
- 34 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 35 1, 2024.
