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9	Relating to state employees; to amend Section 36-1-4.3,
10	Code of Alabama 1975; to expand the deductions that may be
11	made from the salary of state employees; to make
12	nonsubstantive, technical revisions to update the existing
13	code language to current style.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. Section 36-1-4.3, Code of Alabama 1975, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	"§36-1-4.3
18	(a) The state Comptroller shall adopt statewide
19	policies _which_that provide for deductions from the salaries
20	of state employees or groups of state employees whenever a
21	request is presented to the state Comptroller by a group of <u>at</u>
22	<u>least 200</u> participating state employees equal in number to at
23	least 200 provided, however, that deductions being made as of
24	April 23, 1985, shall continue to be made. The deductions
25	shall be made at least monthly and shall be remitted to the
26	appropriate company, association, or organization as specified
27	by the employees. The deductions may be made for membership
28	dues, and voluntary contributions, and insurance premiums, and



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29 financial instruments offered through me	nembership
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associations. Any deduction provided under the provisions of 30 this section may be terminated upon two months' written notice 31 32 in writing by a state employee to the appropriate company, 33 association, or organization and to the appropriate payroll 34 clerk or other appropriate officials as specified by the state 35 Comptroller. 36 (b) The state Comptroller may, at his or her 37 discretion, collect from the deductions withheld under

38 <u>subsection (a)</u> a cost of administration fee not to exceed one 39 percent of the total deduction collected."

40 Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1, 41 2024.
