9	Relating to juveniles; to authorize the state to
10	establish concurrent jurisdiction for criminal offenses
11	committed by children on military installations.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
14	the state shall exercise concurrent jurisdiction with the
15	United States over a military installation of the United
16	States Department of Defense located within this state in a
17	matter relating to a violation of federal law by a child, as
18	defined in Section 12-15-102, Code of Alabama 1975, within the
19	boundaries of that military installation, if both of the
20	following criteria are met:
21	(1) The United States Attorney or the United States
22	District Court for the applicable district in this state
23	waives exclusive jurisdiction.
24	(2) The violation of federal law is also a crime under
25	state law.
26	Section 2. When concurrent jurisdiction has been
27	established pursuant to Section 1, the juvenile court, as
28	defined in Section 12-15-102, Code of Alabama 1975, has
