15	in vitro fertilization process; and to provide retroactive
16	effect.
17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. (a) Related to in vitro fertilization and
19	notwithstanding any provision of law, including any cause of
20	action provided in Chapter 5 of Title 6, Code of Alabama 1975
21	no action, suit, or criminal prosecution for the damage to or
22	death of an embryo shall be brought or maintained against any
23	individual or entity when providing or receiving services
24	related to in vitro fertilization.
25	(b) This section is intended to apply retroactively to
26	any act, omission, or course of services which are not the
27	subject of litigation on the effective date of this act.
28	Section 2.(a) Related to in vitro fertilization and

29	notwithstanding any provision of law, including any cause of
30	action provided in Chapter 5 of Title 6, Code of Alabama 1975,
31	for the damage to or death of an embryo brought against the
32	manufacturer of goods used to facilitate the in vitro
33	fertilization process or the transport of stored embryos,
34	damages shall be limited to compensatory damages calculated as
35	the price paid for the impacted in vitro cycle.
36	(b) Related to in vitro fertilization and
37	notwithstanding any provision of law, no criminal prosecution
38	may be brought for the damage to or death of an embryo against
39	the manufacturer of goods used to facilitate the in vitro
10	fertilization process or the transport of stored embryos.
11	(c) This section is remedial in nature and is intended
12	to apply retroactively.
13	Section 3. This act shall become effective
14	immediately.
