

House Judiciary Reported Substitute for HB82

7	TO BE ENTITLED
8	AN ACT
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10	Relating to crimes and offenses; to amend Section
11	13A-10-9, Code of Alabama 1975, to add additional activity
12	that would constitute the crime of false reporting; to further
13	provide for penalties; to require the payment of restitution
14	in certain circumstances; and in connection therewith would
15	have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or
16	increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of
17	Section 111.05 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022.
18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
19	Section 1. Section 13A-10-9, Code of Alabama 1975, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	"§13A-10-9
22	(a) A person commits the crime of false reporting to
23	<pre>local, state, or federal law enforcement authorities if he or</pre>
24	<pre>she knowingly makes a false report or causes the transmission</pre>
25	of a false report to local , state , or federal law enforcement
26	authorities of a crime or relating to a crime.
27	(b) False reporting to <u>local, state, or federal</u> law
28	enforcement authorities is a Class A misdemeanor, unless the



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29	false report alleges imminent danger to a person or the
30	public, where the penalty shall be a Class C felony.
31	(c) A person convicted of a violation of this section,
32	where the false report results in an emergency response or
33	investigation of the commission of false reporting, shall be
3 4	ordered to pay restitution for the expenses incurred by any
35	local, state, or federal law enforcement or assisting
36	governmental agency. Expenses include any reasonable costs
37	directly incurred, including the costs of police,
38	firefighting, and emergency medical services, and the
39	personnel costs of those persons who respond to the incident."
10	Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose
11	or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of
12	local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements
13	and application under Section 111.05 of the Constitution of
14	Alabama of 2022, because the bill defines a new crime or
15	amends the definition of an existing crime.
16	Section 3. This act shall become effective on October
17	1, 2024.
