24	corruption in which gambling-related interests have

(3) The state also recognizes the history of
gambling-related corruption that has occurred outside
of the State of Alabama.

(4) The purpose of this section is to prevent
quid pro quo corruption and any appearance thereof.
Avoiding corruption and the appearance of corruption
is a necessary condition of authorizing any type of
gambling in the State of Alabama.

(b) The following persons are prohibited or 36 37 otherwise restricted from making contributions or expenditures to a principal campaign committee of a 38 candidate for state or local office in the State of 39 40 Alabama or a political action committee that 41 contributes to any candidate for state or local office 42 in the State of Alabama or from making an electioneering communication: 43

44 (1) A person that holds a license issued by the
45 Alabama Gambling Commission or a person that holds any
46 financial interest in an entity that holds a license
47 issued by the commission.

(2) A person that executes a compact with the



49 state pursuant to Section 65.04 of the Constitution of 50 Alabama of 2022, or a person that holds any financial 51 interest in an entity that executes such a compact 52 with the state.

(3) A person that holds any interest greater
than one percent in the buildings, facilities, or
rooms connected, adjacent, or ancillary to the conduct
of any gambling activity pursuant to a license issued
by the commission or pursuant to a compact with the
state pursuant to Section 65.04 of the Constitution of
Alabama of 2022.

62 (5) A person that holds any financial interest63 in any entity identified in this subsection.

(c) Any person identified in subsection (b) is
also prohibited from making contributions to a
principal campaign committee or a political action
committee that contributes to any candidate for state

76 (d) No agent of a principal campaign committee of a candidate for state or local office in the State 77 78 of Alabama or a political action committee shall 79 knowingly accept a contribution from any person 80 identified in subsection (b) if the principal campaign 81 committee or political action committee has 82 contributed to a candidate for state or local office 83 in the State of Alabama or is reasonably likely to contribute to a candidate for state or local office in 84 the State of Alabama. 85
