House Bill 71 as introduced could increase the obligations of local governments by an undetermined amount dependent on the compensation of certain full-time emergency medical services technicians and paramedics allowed to purchase hazardous duty time for prior eligible service in the Employee's Retirement System (ERS) of Alabama, pursuant to this bill, and the respective employer contribution rates.
