Senate Bill 210 as introduced provides for the state to establish concurrent jurisdiction with the United States for certain criminal offenses committed by juveniles on military installation within the state.

This could increase the obligations of the Unified Judicial System and certain counties, by an undetermined amount, dependent upon the number of cases that are adjudicated in juvenile court as a result of the establishment of concurrent jurisdiction, which could be offset, in whole or in part, dependent upon whether the juvenile court orders a parent or other person legally obligated to care or support a child.
