## **House Bill 62**

**House Bill 62** as passed the House of Representatives provides further for the appointment of retired circuit and district judges to interim active duty status, without regard to the judicial weighted caseload study, which could increase the obligations of the Administrative Office of Courts, or funds within the discretion of the presiding circuit judge, as provided by this bill by a maximum of \$39,000 annually (\$780 per day of service, up to 50 days per year) for any judge that would otherwise not be appointed under current law.
