House Bill 256 as passed the House of Representatives would increase the per diem and mileage rate paid to certain individuals for the extradition of prisoners to the state from \$8 per day and \$0.10 cents per mile, currently, to \$100 per day and the applicable mileage rate paid to state employees (currently \$0.67 per mile). These provisions would increase the obligations of the State General Fund by an undetermined amount dependent upon the difference in: (1) the extradition costs paid under the provisions of this bill; and (2) the costs otherwise paid under current law.

In Fiscal Year 2023, approximately \$1.8 million was paid from the State General Fund for extradition costs.
