Senate Bill 143 as reported by the Committee on Education Policy will increase the administrative obligations of the local superintendents of education and principals and other employees of local school districts to file reports regarding the termination, suspension, or resignation of employment by a teacher or school employee following misconduct or an alleged incident of misconduct pursuant to the provisions of this bill.

Additionally, this bill could increase receipts to the State General Fund and municipal general funds from fines; increase receipts to the State General Fund, county general funds, municipal general funds, and other funds to which court costs are deposited; and could increase the obligations of the State General Fund, district attorneys, and local jails by an undetermined amount dependent upon the number of persons charged with and convicted of the offenses provided by this bill and the penalties imposed.
