House Bill 83 as passed the House of Representatives could increase the obligations of any local board of education that votes to increase board member compensation above \$600 per month, under current law, to no more than \$900 per month as authorized pursuant to the provisions of this bill, by an amount dependent on: (1) the compensation increase from \$600 to \$900 per month as approved by the board; and (2) the number of board members affected.

This bill would also: (1) prohibit a member of a local board of education not in compliance with continuing education and training requirements from receiving compensation, until the member is in compliance; and (2) require all compensation not received by a board member for noncompliance to remain in escrow until the member becomes compliant, or to revert back to the local board of education once the individual is no longer a member of the board.
