| 13 | Section 1. Section 22-8-4, Code of Alabama 1975, is                                   |
| 14 | amended to read as follows:   |

| 16 | <u>(a)</u> Any minor who is 14 years of age or older, <del>or</del> has               |
| 17 | graduated from high school, <del>or</del> is married, or having been                  |
| 18 | married is divorced $_{\underline{\prime}}$ or is pregnant may give effective consent |
| 19 | to any legally authorized medical, dental, health or mental                           |
| 20 | health services for himself or herself, and the consent of no                         |
| 21 | other person shall be is necessary.   |
| 22 | (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), an unemancipated                                  |
| 23 | minor may not give consent to the administration of a                                 |
| 24 | vaccination for himself or herself without the written consent                        |
| 25 | of a parent or legal guardian. Additionally, an unemancipated                         |
| 26 | minor may not give consent to the administration of a                                 |
| 27 | vaccination for himself or herself unless the minor is: (i)                           |
| 28 | not dependent on a parent or legal guardian for support; (ii)                         |

- 29 living apart from his or her parents or another individual
- 30 acting in loco parentis; and (iii) managing his or her own
