Relating to the salaries of public education employees; to provide for a revision of the State Minimum Salary Schedule to reflect a pay increase of two percent beginning with the fiscal year 2024-2025; to provide that each employee of certain boards of education shall receive the pay increase according to placement on the appropriate salary step; to require the appropriate increases on the State Minimum Salary Schedule; to provide support employees with a two percent pay increase beginning with the fiscal year 2024-2025; to require salary schedules; to provide the employees of certain other public educational institutions and schools with a two percent pay increase for the 2024-2025 fiscal year; to provide for an across the board salary increase on all two-year postsecondary salary schedules, to establish other requirements on the two-year postsecondary salary schedules; and to establish miscellaneous pay provisions relating to public education. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

AN ACT

Section 1. PAY INCREASES, FY 2024-2025. (a) The State 29 30 Budget Officer shall allocate to the State Board of Education, 31 the Board of Trustees of the Alabama Institute for Deaf and 32 Blind, the Board of Youth Services School District, the Board 33 of Directors of the Alabama School of Fine Arts, the Board of 34 Directors for the Alabama School of Cyber Technology and 35 Engineering, and the Board of Trustees of the Alabama School 36 of Mathematics and Science and for disbursement to the 37 employees thereof funds based on the criteria established in this act. It is not the intent of this act to make 38 39 appropriations, but the appropriations required by this act shall be made in the annual Education Trust Fund budget act 40 for the designated fiscal year. 41

(1) Certificated Personnel (K-12). For the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024, and each year thereafter, each certificated employee at all city and county school systems and the teachers at the Department of Youth Services School District shall receive a two percent salary increase. Each step and cell on the State Minimum Salary Schedule contained in the annual budget act for the public schools shall be increased by the amounts below for fiscal year 2024-2025, the State Minimum Salary Schedule shall reflect the following percentage increase:

91 All certificated employees, including the Adult Basic 92 Education and Science in Motion employees, shall be quaranteed 93 pay increases in the amounts indicated above for their years of experience and degrees earned and the corresponding pay 94 95 increases shall be reflected in the appropriate local salary 96 schedule and paid to each certificated employee. The 97 provisions and requirements of this act shall be in addition 98 to the provisions of Section 16-13-231.1, Code of Alabama 99 1975, relating to the State Minimum Salary Schedule. Each certificated employee shall be properly placed on the local 100 101 salary schedule according to degree earned and years of public 102 education service (either in-state or out-of-state), which 103 shall be not less than the amounts appropriated for the State 104 Minimum Salary Schedule. The employee shall be paid according 105 to degree earned and length of public education experience. 106 The pay increase shall be given to each person employed for 107 the 2024-2025 fiscal year in addition to any state or local 108 step increase to which the employee is otherwise entitled. The 109 local board of education shall transmit to the State Department of Education the appropriate notice of the earned 110 advanced degree for each employee in a timely fashion; 111 112 thereafter, the employee shall be paid for the advanced degree

- as soon as the degree is certified to the State Department of Education as being earned.
- 115 (2) Education Support Personnel (K-12). A two percent 116 pay increase, beginning with the fiscal year 2024-2025, shall 117 be paid to each public education support worker and adult bus driver, including Adult Basic Education and Science in Motion 118 119 personnel, employed for the 2024-2025 fiscal year in addition 120 to the salary received during the 2023-2024 fiscal year, 121 except employees covered under the state's Merit System at the Department of Youth Services School District. Each governing 122 123 body or authority shall establish and maintain a salary 124 schedule for each class and type of employee and each step of 125 each salary schedule shall be increased to reflect a two 126 percent pay increase beginning with fiscal year 2024-2025, 127 which shall be given to the person employed full-time for the 128 2024-2025 fiscal year and each year employed full-time 129 thereafter. The base rate of pay for part-time support 130 employees shall be increased by two percent beginning with 131 fiscal year 2024-2025. A separate local salary schedule shall
 - (3) AIDB. For the fiscal year 2024-2025, employees at the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind shall receive a pay increase which shall be in excess of their salaries received during the 2023-2024 fiscal year. The increase shall be as follows:

a. Certificated. The salary schedule for certificated employees shall be revised to reflect at least the following percentage increase beginning with the fiscal year 2024-2025:

b. Education Support Personnel (K-12). A two percent pay increase, beginning with the 2024-2025 fiscal year, shall be given to each support worker employed full-time by the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind. A separate local salary schedule shall be established and maintained for each specific job performed. The pay increase in this act shall be incorporated into the support employees' salary schedules. The base rate of pay for part-time support employees shall be increased by two percent for the 2024-2025 fiscal year.

c. Miscellaneous Requirements. The AIDB board shall establish and maintain a salary schedule for each class and type of employee and each step of each salary schedule for fiscal year 2024-2025 shall be increased to reflect the pay increase above to be given to each person employed for the 2024-2025 fiscal year and each year employed thereafter. The

- pay increase contained in this subsection shall be paid to each employee.
- 171 (4) Two-Year Postsecondary Institutions. The Board of 172 Trustees of the Community College System shall revise all 173 salary schedules of the two-year postsecondary institutions to 174 reflect an increase of two percent for the 2024-2025 fiscal 175 year. The pay increase shall be given to each person employed 176 in addition to any step increase to which the employee is 177 otherwise entitled. The Alabama Community College System shall take proper steps to ensure that employees on all salary 178 179 schedules are given full credit for prior work experience in the public schools and colleges, and shall take care to ensure 180 proper placements on the salary schedules. Placement on the 181 182 revised salary schedules shall be in accordance with the 183 employee's length of service in public education. No pay 184 increase shall be given to any two-year postsecondary employee
- 187 (5) Miscellaneous provisions. The following provisions
 188 are hereby established:

- a. Fiscal Year. All salaries and salary increases which are established by the State Board of Education shall be paid in full to each person employed before the end of the applicable fiscal year as defined in Section 16-1-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, as amended.
- b. Extended Work. Public K-12 school employees on
 contracts which extend beyond 187 days, or the hourly
 equivalent thereof, shall be given a pro rata salary increment

197 for each or partial day of work extending beyond 187 days.

- 198 c. Local Increment. Any cost-of-living adjustment 199 and/or increase on the State Minimum Salary Schedule for 200 teachers as provided in this act shall be exclusive of any 201 local pay increase granted or due to teachers under provisions 202 of any local salary schedule. Any cost-of-living adjustment 203 and/or pay increase required by this act for public school 204 support personnel shall be in addition to any pay increase due 205 or granted to the employee under provisions of any local 206 salary schedules. The pay increase provisions of this act 207 shall not apply to any salary supplements granted by local boards of education, bonuses earned for certification by the 208 209 National Board of Professional Teaching Standards, or the 210 federal portion of the salary paid to a Junior Reserve Officer 211 Training Corps (JROTC) instructor employed by a local school 212 board.
 - d. Community Education. Each county and city board of education shall have the option to exclude from the provisions of this act any part-time employees of community education or school-sponsored child care or child enrichment program which is supplemental to the state-required educational program.

- e. Local Chief Executive Officers. The pay increase provisions of this act shall not apply to superintendents of education of any school system or institution. Any pay increase given to the superintendent shall be by majority recorded vote of the governing body or authority.
- Section 2. The pay increase granted in this act shall begin in fiscal year 2024-2025 and continue in subsequent

225	years. Nothing in this act shall authorize additional pay
226	increases in subsequent years.
227	Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable. If
228	any part of this act is declared invalid or unconstitutional,
229	that declaration shall not affect the part which remains.
230	Section 4. This act shall become immediately following
231	its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise
232	becoming law.
