5	This bill would exempt food pantries in Cullman
6	County that meet certain criteria from payment of all
7	state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes on
8	items purchased for charitable purposes.

12	TO BE ENTITLED
13	AN ACT
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15	Relating to state, county, and municipal sales and use
16	taxes; to exempt food pantries in Cullman County from all
17	state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes for certain
18	purchases.
19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this act, a "food
21	pantry" is a charitable, nonprofit organization which
22	collects, purchases, or otherwise accumulates items for
23	distribution without any charge for charitable purposes.
24	(b) Any food pantry in Cullman County is exempt from
25	payment of all state, county, and municipal sales and use
26	taxes on the purchase of items used for charitable purposes,
27	provided the food pantry has been granted status as a tax
28	exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the federal

## HB178 INTRODUCED



Internal Revenue Code and provided it pays no person any salary or expenses for the performance of any duties related to its charitable operations.

32 Section 2. This act shall become effective on September 33 1, 2024.
