4 SYNOPSIS:

Under the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, only the Governor may call the Legislature into a special session.

This bill would authorize members of the
Legislature to request the convening of a special
session with the Secretary of State, who, once he or
she receives the requisite number of requests, would be
required to poll all members of the Legislature. If a
majority of members of both houses vote in the
affirmative, the Secretary of State would notify the
President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of
the House of Representatives, who would be required to
issue a joint proclamation calling the Legislature into
a special session.

Proposing to amend Section 76 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and add a new section to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to authorize the Legislature to call itself into a special session and provide for the process for

- 30 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 31 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
- 32 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:
- 33 PROPOSED AMENDMENT
- 34 "SSec.Section 76
- 35 When the legislature shall be Legislature is convened
- 36 in special session, there shall be no legislation upon
- 37 subjects other than those designated in the proclamation of
- 38 the governor calling such for the convening of the special
- 39 session, except by a vote of two-thirds of each house. Special
- 40 sessions shall be limited to 12 legislative days and thirty30
- 41 calendar days."
- A new section is added to the Constitution of Alabama
- 43 of 2022 to read as follows:
- 44 (a) In addition to Section 122 of the constitution, the
- 45 Legislature may also be convened in special session as
- 46 provided in this section.
- 47 (b) When 30 percent of the members of the Legislature
- 48 request in writing the convening of the Legislature in a
- 49 special session and submit the request to the Secretary of
- 50 State, the Secretary of State, within seven days after
- receiving the requisite number of written requests, shall poll
- 52 members of the Legislature, and upon the affirmative vote of a
- 53 majority of the members of both houses, shall immediately
- notify the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker
- 55 of the House of Representatives. The President Pro Tempore of
- 56 the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives



57	shall immediately issue a joint proclamation calling for the
58	convening of a special session under the same conditions and
59	limitations in subsection (b) of Section 48.01 and Section 122
60	and shall set the time for convening the special session,
61	which shall not be less than 14 days, nor more than 21 days
62	from the date of notification from the Secretary of State.

- (c) If the Secretary of State fails to receive the requisite number of written requests to convene the Legislature in a special session within a period of 60 days after receipt of the first written request, all written requests received by the Secretary of State shall be rendered void and no special session shall be called. The written requests shall not be used at any future time for the convening of the Legislature.
- 71 (d) Nothing in this section shall affect the authority
 72 of the Governor to convene a special session under Section 122
 73 of the constitution.

74 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as 75 76 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional 77 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: 78 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation 79 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest 80 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise 81 internal or external citations and cross-references; and translate effective dates. 82

83 END OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment



85	shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
86	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this
87	state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot
88	number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the
89	election ballot and shall set forth the following description
90	of the substance or subject matter of the proposed
91	constitutional amendment:
92	"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama
93	of 2022, to amend Section 76 and add a new section authorizing
94	the Legislature to call itself into a special session under
95	certain conditions.
96	Proposed by Act"
97	This description shall be followed by the following
98	language:
99	"Yes() No()."
100	Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as
101	a part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved
102	by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
