17	Relating to public K-12 schools; to prohibit public
18	K-12 schools from taking certain actions regarding dependent
19	children of active duty military parents; and to prohibit
20	public K-12 schools from membership in athletic associations
21	that take these same actions.
22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
23	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
24	term "athletic association" means any athletic organization
25	operating in this state that has authority over its member
26	institutions' athletic programs, that receives public funds i
27	any form, and whose member institutions make use of public

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facilities.



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29	(b)(1) No public K-12 school may deny, nor be a member
30	of an athletic association that denies, a dependent child of a
31	full-time active duty military parent immediate eligibility to
32	participate in an interscholastic athletic contest on the
33	basis of the child enrolling in a new school due to the child
34	and his or her parent making a bona fide move pursuant to
35	permanent change of station orders received by the parent,
36	regardless of the date upon which the child enrolls in the new
37	school or the school attendance zone in which the new school
38	is located.
39	(2) A public K-12 school and an athletic association
40	may require a parent to provide his or her permanent change of
41	station orders to substantiate a bona fide move that
42	necessitates a child's enrollment in a new school.
43	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
44	1, 2024.
