

- 1 Enrolled, An Act,
- 2 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama
- of 2022, relating to Choctaw County, to authorize the
- 4 Legislature to fix, alter, and regulate court costs in the
- 5 county and to provide for their distribution.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
- 8 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:
- 9 PROPOSED AMENDMENT
- The Legislature, by local law, may fix, regulate, and
- 11 alter the costs and charges of courts in Choctaw County and
- 12 provide for their distribution.
- 13 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
- 14 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
- 15 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
- 16 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:
- 17 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation
- 18 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest
- 19 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise
- 20 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize
- 21 language; and translate effective dates.
- 22 END PROPOSED AMENDMENT
- Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
- 24 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285
- of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws
- of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign
- a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on
- 28 the election ballot and shall set forth the following





- description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:
- "Relating to Choctaw County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to authorize the
- 33 Legislature, by local law, to fix, regulate, and alter the
- 34 costs and charges of court and to provide for their
- 35 distribution.
- 36 Proposed by Act ."
- This description shall be followed by the following
- 38 language:
- "Yes() No()."
- Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as
- part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by
- 42 a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
