21	vehicle license and registration year commencing on January 1,

renewal on any vehicle in the county commencing with the motor vehicle license and registration year commencing on January 1, 2025, if levied prior thereto. If the county commission desires to levy the fee, the fee shall be levied prior to December 1, 2024. Thereafter, the county commission may not levy or amend or reduce the fee. The fee authorized by this section shall only be for one continuing annual two dollar (\$2) fee. The License Commissioner of the county or other
