20	possession, control, care, or custody a pistol that has a part

24	(c) A violation of this section is a Class C felony.
25	(d) This section does not apply to either of the

27	(1) A state or local law enforcement officer while



(2) A person who owns or has in his or her possession,
control, care, or custody a firearm, part, or combination of
part that are registered in the National Firearms Registration
and Transfer Record maintained by the Bureau of Alcohol,
Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives or is otherwise not subject
to that registration requirement.
(3) Any part, combination of parts, or device designed
or intended to increase a pistol's rate of fire but that does
not enable a semiautomatic pistol to fire more than one shot,
without manual reloading, by a single function of the trigger.
Section 2. This act shall become effective on October

1, 2024.
