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9	Relating to Cullman County; to authorize and direct the
10	sheriff to take certain actions regarding abandoned and stolen
11	firearms.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
14	term "firearm" shall have the same meaning as defined in
15	Section 13A-8-1, Code of Alabama 1975.
16	(b) The Sheriff of Cullman County shall keep and
17	maintain a separate permanent record of all abandoned and
18	stolen firearms not subject to disposition by general law. The
19	records shall include a description of the firearm, the date
20	of recovery of the firearm, the serial or other identifying
21	number, if any, of the firearm, and the place of recovery of
22	the firearm.
23	(c) Unless otherwise provided by law, the sheriff may
24	sell or destroy a firearm if all of the following have
25	occurred:
26	(1) The firearm has been recorded pursuant to
27	subsection (b).
28	(2) The sheriff has possessed the firearm for at least

- 30 (3) The owner of the firearm has not claimed the
- 31 firearm.
- 32 (d)(1) The sheriff may sell or trade firearms pursuant
- 33 to subsection (c) only to gun dealers who have held an active
- 34 business license in this state for at least one year
- immediately prior to the date of the sale or trade.
- 36 (2) The sheriff shall establish a procedure to notify
- 37 gun dealers of all firearms available for trade or sale.
- 38 (3) Proceeds of a sale, after deducting and paying all
- 39 expenses incurred in the recovery, maintenance, and sale of
- 40 the firearm, shall be dispersed as follows:
- a. Seventy percent to the office of the sheriff.
- b. Thirty percent to the office of the district
- 43 attorney.
- (e) The sheriff may establish a procedure to destroy
- 45 firearms and may expend necessary sheriff department funds for
- 46 that purpose.
- 47 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 48 1, 2024.
