5	This bill would allow a district attorney,
6	assistant district attorney, deputy district attorney,
7	retired district attorney, and supernumerary district
8	attorney to advise law enforcement on any matter of
9	criminal procedure, civil procedure, criminal charges,
10	criminal investigation, or any matters of law.
11	This bill would also provide a district
12	attorney, assistant district attorney, deputy district
13	attorney, and supernumerary district attorney with
14	absolute immunity in the performance of his or her
15	duties.

29 district attorney, and supernumerary district attorney are 30 provided absolute immunity in certain circumstances. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 31 32 Section 1. Section 12-17-184.1 is added to the Code of 33 Alabama 1975, to read as follows: 34 \$12-17-184.1 35 A district attorney, assistant district attorney, 36 deputy district attorney, retired district attorney, and 37 supernumerary district attorney when called into service pursuant to Section 12-17-216, may advise a law enforcement 38 39 officer or a law enforcement agency, as defined in Section 36-21-55, on any matter of criminal procedure, civil 40 procedure, criminal charges, criminal investigations, or other 41 matters of law. 42 43 Section 2. A district attorney, assistant district 44 attorney, deputy district attorney, retired district attorney, 45 and supernumerary district attorney when called into service 46 pursuant to Section 12-17-216, Code of Alabama 1975, shall 47 have absolute immunity from any civil suit arising from the 48 execution of any duty or any function assigned by law.

49 Section 3. This act shall become effective on June 1,50 2024.
