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SYNOPSIS:

This bill would provide that the World Health Organization and the World Economic Forum shall have no jurisdiction or power within the State of Alabama.

This bill would further provide that no rules, regulations, fees, taxes, policies, or mandates of any kind, which are passed by any of the aforementioned entities, shall be enforced or implemented by the State of Alabama or any political subdivision thereof.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to certain international organizations; to provide that certain international organizations shall have no jurisdiction or power in the State of Alabama.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The World Health Organization and the World Economic Forum shall have no jurisdiction or power within the State of Alabama. No rule, regulation, fee, tax, policy, or mandate of any kind of the World Health Organization or the World Economic Forum shall be enforced or implemented by this state or any agency, department, board, commission, or

33 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
