9	Relating to Jefferson County; to authorize persons
10	employed by the county whose duties include the investigation,
11	prosecution, and enforcement of county ordinance violations or
12	any local laws of the county to be designated as peace
13	officers under certain conditions.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. In Jefferson County, any persons employed by
16	the county whose duties include the investigation,
17	prosecution, and enforcement of county ordinance violations or
18	any local law of the county may be designated by his or her
19	appointing authority as a peace officer in this state with the
20	authority to execute warrants on persons charged by a warrant
21	lawfully issued or by other lawful process with a violation of
22	a county ordinance or local law. Any person designated as
23	peace officer shall meet the minimum standards for law
24	enforcement officers and shall hold a current certification
25	from the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training
26	Commission. The person designated as a peace officer under
27	this section shall have the same protection as a deputy
28	sheriff in this state.
