15	Section 1. Section 9 of Act 2022-279, 2022 Regular
L 6	Session, is amended to read as follows:
L7	"Section 9. $\underline{\text{(a)}}$ The judge of probate may mail to any
18	person to whom a motor vehicle license has been previously
L 9	issued an application for renewal of a license required to be
20	returned prior to the expiration date of the license. The
21	application for renewal may be in the form of a postcard and
22	shall contain sufficient information to adequately identify
23	and process the renewal. The signature of the licensee on the
24	application and proper remittance shall constitute sufficient
25	authority for the judge of probate to issue the license and
26	return the license to the licensee by mail. The county
27	commission may establish a fee to be entitled "Mail Order Fee'

in an amount not to exceed three dollars (\$3) to pay the cost

29	of this mailing procedure. The county commission may establish
30	an additional fee, not to exceed a total of ten dollars (\$10),
31	if the licensee requests to receive a license plate or decal
32	by priority mail. The fee fees shall be collected by the judge
33	of probate at the time of issuance and paid over to the
34	general fund of the county as are other fees and commissions.
35	(b) The judge of probate may charge up to five dollars
36	(\$5) for the cost of mailing any other probate document."
37	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
38	1, 2024.
