1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to Franklin County; to provide for the annual
3 expense allowance and salary and other benefits for the
4 coroner; and to further authorize the Franklin County
5 Commission to appropriate and expend funds for the operation
6 of the office of the coroner.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. (a) The Coroner of Franklin County shall
9 receive an expense allowance in the amount of nine thousand
10 seven hundred dollars (\$9,700) per annum, which shall be in
11 addition to all other expense allowances, compensation, or
12 salary provided by law. The expense allowance shall be paid in
13 equal monthly installments from the general fund of the
14 county.

15 (b) Effective beginning the next term of office, the
16 expense allowance provided for in subsection (a) shall be
17 void, and the Coroner of Franklin County shall receive an
18 annual salary of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to be paid in
19 equal monthly installments from the general fund of the
20 county. The salary in this subsection shall be the total
21 compensation paid to the coroner, subject to the adjustments
22 provided in subsection (c).

23 (c) In addition to the salary provided in subsection
24 (b), the salary of the coroner shall be increased by any
25 uniform increases in compensation granted equally to all
26 county employees by the Franklin County Commission. In
27 addition, the coroner may participate in the county health
28 insurance plan and any retirement plan provided to county

29 employees under the same terms as county employees.

30 (d) The Franklin County Commission may appropriate and
31 expend county funds for the coroner's salary, benefits, and
32 expenses necessary for the operation of the office of the
33 coroner. The commission may provide the coroner with expenses
34 for the operation of a motor vehicle or may furnish the
35 coroner with the use of a county vehicle.

36 (e) The Franklin County Commission may authorize the
37 coroner to appoint one or more deputy coroners to perform the
38 duties of the coroner in the absence of the coroner and
39 provide for the compensation of any deputy coroner appointed.

40 Section 2. Act 1185, 1969 Regular Session (Acts 1969,
41 p. 2213), as amended by Act 90-461, 1990 Regular Session (Acts
42 1990, p. 653); Act 491, 1971 Regular Session (Acts 1971, p.
43 1205); and Act 446, 1973 Regular Session (Acts 1973, p. 636)
44 are repealed.

45 Section 3. This act shall become effective on June 1,
46 2024.
