7	AN ACT
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9	Relating to asbestos actions; to amend Sections
10	6-5-691, 6-5-692, and 6-5-693, Code of Alabama 1975, to
11	further provide for various requirements for asbestos actions;
12	and to authorize a defendant in an asbestos action to be
13	dismissed if certain requirements are not met.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. Sections 6-5-691, 6-5-692, and 6-5-693, Code
16	of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:
17	"§6-5-691
18	For the purposes of this article, the following terms
19	shall have the following meanings:
20	(1) ASBESTOS ACTION. A civil action arising out of,
21	based on, or related to the health effects of exposure to
22	asbestos and any derivative claim made by or on behalf of a
23	person exposed to asbestos or a representative, spouse,
24	parent, child, or other relative of that person. The term
25	asbestos action does not include claims alleging ovarian
26	cancer.
27	(2) ASBESTOS TRUST. A government-approved or

28 court-approved trust, qualified settlement fund, compensation



fund, or claims facility that is created as a result of an administrative or legal action, a court-approved bankruptcy, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 524(g), 11 U.S.C. § 1121(a), or other applicable provision of law, that is intended, in whole or in part, to provide compensation to claimants arising out of, based on, or related to the health effects of exposure to asbestos.

36 (3) EXPOSED PERSON. A person whose exposure to asbestos
 37 or to asbestos-containing products is the basis for an
 38 asbestos action.

39 (3) (4) TRUST CLAIM MATERIALS. A final executed proof of claim and all documents and information submitted to or 40 received from an asbestos trust, including claim forms and 41 42 supplementary materials, affidavits, medical and health 43 records, depositions and trial testimony of the plaintiff and others knowledgeable about the plaintiff's exposure history, 44 work history, exposure allegations, and all documents that 45 46 reflect the status of a claim against an asbestos trust and if 47 the trust claim has been resolved.

48 (4)(5) TRUST GOVERNANCE DOCUMENTS. All documents that 49 relate to eligibility and payment levels, including claims 50 payment matrices, trust distribution procedures, or plans for 51 reorganization, for an asbestos trust."

(a) Subject to Section 6-5-693, within 90 days after aA
plaintiff who files an asbestos action, the plaintiff within
<u>45 days</u>, shall do all of the following: provide

56 (1) Provide all parties with an affidavit, signed under



57 oathinformation form attested by the plaintiff, specifying the 58 basis for each claim against each defendant and stating all of 59 the following with specificity: 60 a.(1) The plaintiff's exposed person's name, address, 61 date of birth, Social Security number, marital status, smoking 62 history, occupation, and current and past worksites and 63 employers, and if the plaintiff exposed person alleges 64 exposure to asbestos through another person, the identity of the other person $_{\mathcal{T}}$ and that person's relationship to the 65 plaintiffexposed person. 66 67 b.(2) The asbestos-related disease claimed to exist. c.(3) TheAn affirmation that the plaintiff and 68 plaintiff'shis or her counsel have conducted an investigation 69 70 into all potential sources of the plaintiff's exposed person's 71 exposure to asbestos and identified. (4) The identity, with specificity, of each and every 72 73 source of exposure to asbestos that is available or known to 74 the plaintiff or plaintiff'shis or her counsel for the exposed 75 person and any person through which the plaintiff alleges 76 exposure, including all asbestos-containing products to which 77 the plaintiffexposed person or other person was exposed, 78 whether from bankrupt entities or otherwise, and all premises 79 at which the plaintiff and the other exposed person werewas 80 exposed to asbestos; the. 81 (5) The specific location and manner of each alleged 82 exposure to asbestos; the. (6) The beginning and ending dates of each alleged 83 84 exposure; and the.



85	(7) The specific connection of each defendant to the
86	alleged exposure to asbestos.
87	(8) The name, address, and relationship to the exposed

88 person of each individual who is knowledgeable regarding the 89 exposed person's exposures to asbestos.

90 (2)(9) Provide all parties with all<u>All</u> supporting 91 documentation relating to this the information required by 92 this section.

(b) If a defendant that is specifically identified in 93 the plaintiff's attestation as a source of exposure presents 94 95 evidence that the plaintiff's affidavitattestation is incomplete, the defendant may move the court for an order to 96 97 require the plaintiff to supplement the affidavitattestation. If the court determines that there is a sufficient basis for 98 99 the plaintiff to supplement the affidavitattestation, the court shall enter an order to require the plaintiff to 100 101 supplement the affidavitattestation and shall stay the action 102 until the plaintiff supplements the affidavitattestation as 103 provided by the court and produces the supplemental 104 affidavitattestation to the parties.

(c) The court shall dismiss the plaintiff's claim without prejudice if the plaintiff fails to provide the information required in this section or fails to satisfy an order to supplement the plaintiff's <u>affidavitattestation</u> within <u>90 days from</u> the time the information is required to be provided to the parties.

111 (d) A defendant whose product or premises is not 112 specifically identified in the plaintiff's attestation may



113 file a motion with the court to dismiss the plaintiff's claim against that defendant without prejudice." 114 "\$6-5-693 115 116 (a) A plaintiff in an asbestos action need not comply with Section 6-5-692 if, within 90Within 60 days after the 117 plaintiff files an asbestos action, the plaintiff files shall 118 119 file all available asbestos trust claims and provides provide 120 the parties with all trust claim materials available to the plaintiff or plaintiff's his or her counsel in relation to the 121 plaintiff's exposed person's exposure to asbestos. This 122 123 section does not apply if the plaintiff complies with Section 6-5-692. 124

(b) A plaintiff has a continuing duty to supplement the information and materials provided under subsection (a) within 30 days after the plaintiff supplements an asbestos trust claim, receives additional information or materials related to an asbestos trust claim, or files an additional trust claim.

130 (c) Not less than 60 days before trial, if a defendant 131 presents evidence that the plaintiff has not filed all 132 available asbestos trust claims, as required under subsection 133 (a), the defendant may move the court for an order to require 134 the plaintiff to file additional trust claims. If a defendant 135 has previously filed a motion under this section, the court 136 shall not grant a subsequent motion if the defendant knew that 137 the claimant met the criteria for payment for the additional 138 trust claim identified in the subsequent motion at the time the earlier motion was filed. 139

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(d) Trial in an asbestos action may not begin until at



141 least 60 days after the plaintiff complies with this section." 142 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October 143 1, 2024.
