7 WHEREAS, we take great pride and pleasure in
8 commending Lieutenant General A.C. Roper for his outstanding
9 accomplishments; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant General A.C. Roper is the Deputy 10 Commander, U.S. Northern Command, and Vice Commander, U.S. 11 12 Element, North American Aerospace Defense Command at 13 Peterson Air Force Base, Colorado; as Deputy Commander, 14 Lieutenant General Roper assists the Combatant Commander in 15 anticipating, preparing for, and responding to threats against North America and within Northern Command's assigned 16 area of responsibility; additionally, he provides oversight 17 of U.S. Northern Command's mission to provide Defense 18 19 Support of Civil Authorities; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant General Roper's other general 20 21 officer level assignments include duties as Deputy 22 Commanding General, U.S. Army Reserve Command, Fort Bragg, 23 North Carolina, and Deputy Chief, Army Reserve, Office of 24 the Chief of Army Reserve, headquartered at the Pentagon, 25 Washington, D.C.; prior to this assignment he commanded the 26 76th Operational Response Command in Salt Lake City, Utah, which was the USAR's all hazard response command; he also 27 28 served as Commanding General - 80th Training Command (OPCON

29 to TRADOC), Acting Deputy Commanding General - CBRN, 335th 30 Signal Command and Commander of the 415th CBRN Brigade where he was dual-hatted as the Task Force Operations Commander, 31 32 JTF-51, ARNORTH for the C2CRE-A homeland response mission; 33 Lieutenant General Roper deployed to Saudi Arabia during Operation Desert Shield and to Afghanistan in support of 34 35 Operation Enduring Freedom; he also supported Joint Task 36 Force Andrew relief operations in Southern Florida; and

37 WHEREAS, Lieutenant General Roper was commissioned in 38 1983 at The University of Alabama at Birmingham; his military education includes the Chemical Officer Basic and 39 Advance Courses (Honor Graduate of both), Public Affairs 40 41 Officers Course, Equal Opportunity Advisors Course 42 (Commandant's Award), Inspector General Course, Combined 43 Arms Staff Services School, Command and General Staff College (Commandant's List), the U.S. Army War College, the 44 45 Joint Senior Reserve Component Officer Course, the Defense 46 Support to Civil Authorities (DSCA) Course, the National Defense University's CAPSTONE Course, the NORTHCOM Joint 47 Task Force Commanders Course, and Harvard University's 48 49 National and International Security Seminar; he earned a 50 Master of Science from The University of Alabama and a Master in Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College; 51 52 and

57 Leaf Clusters, Joint Service Commendation Medal, Combat Action Badge, and various other awards; he also served as a 58 principal member of the Secretary of the Army's Army Reserve 59 Forces Policy Committee and the Secretary of Defense's 60 61 Reserve Forces Policy Board; in his civilian capacity, Lieutenant General Roper has over 33 years of law 62 63 enforcement experience culminating with his 10-year tenure 64 as the Chief of Police of the Birmingham Police Department; 65 he is a graduate of the Federal Bureau of Investigation 66 (FBI) National Academy, the FBI National Executive Institute, and also serves as an Adjunct Professor of 67 Criminal Justice; he specialized in protecting critical 68 infrastructure and served on the Executive Board of the FBI 69 70 Joint Terrorism Task Force; he and his wife, Edith, have been married for 38 years and are the proud parents of two 71 adult daughters; now therefore, 72
