7	WHEREAS, the Alabama Holocaust Commission will host a
8	2024 State Yom HaShoah Commemoration on May 2, 2024, to
9	observe the passage of Yom HaShoah; the Alabama Holocaust
10	Commission is overjoyed to announce that this year's Yom
11	HaShoah Commemoration will be held at the Alabama Department
12	of Archives and History; and
13	WHEREAS, Yom HaShoah was instituted by Israel in 1951
14	as a day of commemoration for the 6,000,000 Jewish men,
15	women, and children who perished in the Holocaust, the
16	largest manifestation of hate and intolerance in modern
17	history; and
18	WHEREAS, there is no institutionalized ritual for Yom
19	HaShoah; commemorations may include synagogue services,
20	communal vigils, and educational programs; the lighting of
21	memorial candles and reciting of prayers for the departed
22	are generally featured in the solemn ceremony; and
23	WHEREAS, Alabamians not only mourn the Jews lost in
24	the Holocaust, but the Holocaust survivors who have died
25	within the last year will be dearly missed after decades of
26	sharing their stories and spreading awareness of the horrors
27	they personally witnessed and their memories of those who

30	the squalid conditions; the forced labor; the hideous
31	medical experiments; the starvation; and the gas chambers
32	that drove home the unspeakable horrors they endured; and
33	WHEREAS, American screenwriter and playwright Rod
3 4	Serling spoke these words on why humanity must never forget
35	the Holocaust and why the concentration camps must never be
36	torn down, "All the Dachaus must remain standing. The
37	Dachaus, the Belsens, the Buchenwalds, the Auschwitzes; all
38	of them. They must remain standing because they are a
3 9	monument to a moment in time when some men decided to turn
40	the Earth into a graveyard. Into it they shoveled all of
41	their reason, their logic, their knowledge, but worst of
42	all, their conscience. And the moment we forget this, the
43	moment we cease to be haunted by its remembrance, then we
4 4	become the gravediggers. Something to remember, not just in
45	The Twilight Zone, but wherever men walk God's Earth."; now
