

4	COMMENDING COACH NICK SABAN FOR HIS PROFESSIONAL
5	ACHIEVEMENTS AND EXEMPLARY LEADERSHIP ON THE OCCASION OF HIS
6	RETIREMENT.

8	WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure,
9	highest honors, commendations, and congratulations are
10	conveyed to Coach Nicholas Lou Saban, Jr. for his retirement
11	after a five-decade career that included head coaching
12	positions at the University of Toledo, Michigan State
13	University, Louisiana State University (LSU), the Miami
14	Dolphins, and, most notably, The University of Alabama (UA),
15	where Coach Saban achieved his most monumental coaching
16	accolades and changed the landscape of college football
17	forever; and
18	WHEREAS, under Coach Saban, Alabama Football made an
19	appearance at No. 1 in the AP Poll in an unprecedented 15
20	consecutive seasons and held the No. 1 rank for a record
21	total of 109 weeks over 17 seasons; since Coach Saban took

total of 109 weeks over 17 seasons; since Coach Sabah took over, Alabama Football has had 17 more victories than any other NCAA FBS program; during his legacy with the Crimson Tide, Coach Saban has become one of only 11 college football coaches to win over 200 games at one major-college football program; he had 57 consecutive non-conference regular season wins at UA, the longest streak in the nation during the Southeastern Conference (SEC) era; Coach Saban led the Tide



29 to 88 wins in 98 games as the No. 1 team in the AP Poll, 30 both of which are records; and he led the Tide to a record 31 16 consecutive 10-win seasons; and

32 WHEREAS, Coach Saban signed 10 No. 1 recruiting 33 classes during his tenure with the Crimson Tide; he coached the University's four Heisman Trophy winners, making him the 34 35 only coach in SEC history to produce multiple Heisman Trophy 36 winners; he produced a record 49 NFL first-round picks over 37 his career, 44 of which he produced at UA; Coach Saban is 38 one of four coaches in the common draft era to have more than 160 players selected in the NFL Draft; under Coach 39 Saban, the Tide has produced 60 national award winning 40 41 players; Coach Saban's players at UA have won 66 All-America 42 honors; eight players have been named two-time 43 All-Americans, including the first two-time unanimous All-American in Alabama history, Will Anderson, Jr.; and 44

45 WHEREAS, no SEC team holds a winning record against 46 Coach Saban; he and his predecessor, Paul "Bear" Bryant, are the only two coaches to win SEC Championships at two 47 different schools; Coach Saban is the only coach to win 11 48 49 SEC Championships outright, nine of which were won at UA; he 50 is the second winningest head coach in number of wins with a single school in SEC history with 206 wins; and he is the 51 52 second winningest head coach in SEC history in number of 53 overall wins with 254 and SEC regular-season wins with 148; 54 and

55 WHEREAS, Coach Saban is regarded by many as the 56 greatest college football coach of all time; he is the only



57 coach to boast nine victories against the No. 1 team in the AP Poll, 30 wins against teams ranked in the top five of the 58 AP Poll, and 104 wins against ranked opponents; he holds the 59 longest winning streak against unranked opponents in NCAA 60 61 FBS history at 100 wins; he is the only coach to win a national championship at two different Division-I FBS 62 63 schools; he is the only college football head coach to win seven national championships, six of which were won at UA; 64 65 of the 10 seasons that the College Football Playoff (CFP) 66 has existed, Coach Saban's Crimson Tide has qualified a record eight times; he is the only head coach to play in 14 67 CFP games, win 9 CFP games, and win 3 CFP national 68 69 championships; during his 28 seasons as a collegiate head 70 coach, Saban never led a college football team that ended 71 the season with a losing record; he leads all active college football coaches in wins with 297, win percentage at 80.6 72 percent, and bowl wins with 19; and Coach Saban's renowned 73 74 297 wins designate him as the sixth winningest head coach in 75 FBS history; and

WHEREAS, Nick Saban is a member of the Alabama Sports 76 77 Hall of Fame, the Kent State Varsity K Hall of Fame, and the 78 Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame; he has won a plethora of prestigious coaching awards including, among others, the 79 80 Associated Press National Coach of the Year Award in 2003 81 and 2008; the Paul "Bear" Bryant Award in 2003 and 2020; the FWAA/Eddie Robinson Award in 2003 and 2008; the Walter Camp 82 83 Coach of the Year Award in 2008 and 2018; the Bobby Bowden National Collegiate Coach of the Year Award in 2009, 2011, 84



and 2012; the George Munger Award in 2016; the Bobby Dodd Coach of the Year Award in 2014; the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award in 2008; the Home Depot Coach of the Year Award in 2008; the Sporting News Coach of the Year Award in 2008; and the SEC Coach of the Year Award in 2003, 2008, 2009, 2016, and 2020; and

91 WHEREAS, a Fairmont, West Virginia native, Coach 92 Saban graduated from Kent State University in 1973, where he 93 played safety on the Golden Flashes football team; Coach 94 Saban also began his coaching career at his alma mater as a 95 graduate assistant in 1973; in 1975, Coach Saban earned his 96 master's degree from Kent State University; and

97 WHEREAS, Coach Saban has achieved much more than success on the football field as an exemplary coach, mentor, 98 99 and community leader; during his time as the head coach of 100 the Crimson Tide, Coach Saban's players have earned a total of 656 degrees, including 103 master's degrees; and for his 101 102 unforgettable contributions to the community, his family has been honored by having a street named "Nick's Kids Avenue" 103 after the Nick's Kids Foundation; and 104

105 WHEREAS, Coach Saban, along with his wife, Terry 106 Saban, have made incredibly generous donations to The University of Alabama Scholarship Fund; he has donated over 107 108 \$1 million dollars to The University of Alabama's 109 First-Generation Scholarship Program; he has also donated \$1 million dollars to UA's Athletics Foundation, The Crimson 110 111 Standard; with the support of and donations from Coach Saban, the St. Francis Catholic Church in Tuscaloosa built 112



113 the Saban Catholic Student Center; Coach Saban played a vital role in tornado relief following the devastating 114 115 tornado on April 27, 2011; Coach Saban purchased and served meals to those in need at shelters immediately following the 116 117 tragedy that struck Tuscaloosa and the surrounding areas; he 118 also joined with Habitat for Humanity to build 21 homes; and 119 while at LSU, Coach Saban raised over \$100,000 per year for 120 the Children's Miracle Network on top of supporting many 121 other charitable and civic projects in Louisiana and working 122 as a fundraiser for LSU's Student-Athlete Academic Center; 123 and

124 WHEREAS, named in honor of Nick Saban, Sr., the 125 Nick's Kids Foundation has helped bolster and improve the 126 lives and futures of countless youth in Alabama through its 127 contributions of over \$12 million to students, teachers, 128 families, and children's causes at over 150 charities; these 129 contributions include, but are in no way limited to: 130 renovation of the STTEP Building of Brewer Porch Children's 131 Center; the Tuscaloosa Riverwalk Playground; career tech 132 classrooms at the Tuscaloosa County Juvenile Detention Center; the Alberta School of Performing Arts playground; 133 134 and the Tuscaloosa Public Library; and

WHEREAS, in creating a lasting legacy in Tuscaloosa, Coach Saban has supported and partnered with the City of Tuscaloosa to develop the Saban Center as the combined home of Ignite, a new STEM Discovery Center, the State of Alabama STEM Hub, and the Tuscaloosa Children's Theatre; and the Saban Center also brought to Tuscaloosa the All-Inclusive



141 Playground; and

142 WHEREAS, Coach Saban remains beloved and highly 143 esteemed by players, students, fans, The University of 144 Alabama and other university communities that he called 145 home, and by the people of our great State of Alabama; now 146 therefore,

147 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 148 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That this body regards, reveres, 149 and honors Nick Saban in the highest manner for his numerous 150 professional accolades and model citizenship; and, along with best wishes for continued success during his 151 152 retirement, we hereby dedicate this resolution to him as an 153 exemplary leader with the utmost respect, gratitude, and 154 admiration for all that he has done and accomplished for the 155 State of Alabama, The University of Alabama, and the 156 countless lives that he has positively impacted through his 157 charitable endeavors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be presented to Coach Nick Saban and The University of Alabama as a demonstration of our unrivaled gratitude, admiration, and respect.
