8	WHEREAS, over 300,000 public officials and public
9	employees and their families, from statewide elected
10	officials to local public servants such as teachers and
11	firefighters, are subject to the ethics laws of this state;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, the people of Alabama are best served by
14	clearly articulated ethical standards and policies, well
15	guarded from the risks of corruption, so that our state's
16	public servants and the general public can better ensure
17	that our government operates with confidence and integrity;
18	now therefore,
19	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
20	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Director of the
21	Legislative Services Agency is directed to hire a person
22	with national expertise and experience from outside of the
23	state in the field of governmental ethics to study the State
24	of Alabama's ethics laws and report his or her findings and
25	recommendations to the Director the Speaker of the House of
