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4	HJR ENCOURAGING STATE ENTITIES TO HIRE AND ADVANCE
5	INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES.
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7	WHEREAS, Alabama is home to over 800,000 working-age
8	Alabamians with disabilities; and
9	WHEREAS, employment provides opportunities for
10	individuals with disabilities to be financially independent,
11	demonstrate their skills and abilities, and access the full
12	benefits of our community; and
13	WHEREAS, the employment rate of individuals with
14	disabilities continues to remain unacceptably lower than
15	individuals without disabilities; 38.1 percent of Alabamians
16	with disabilities between 21 and 64 years of age were
17	employed in 2022, compared to 78.1 percent of their peers
18	living without a disability; the percentage of individuals
19	with disabilities living in poverty is typically more than
20	double that of their peers living without a disability; and
21	WHEREAS, the Legislature is strongly committed to
22	encouraging and supporting individuals with disabilities to
23	participate in the social and economic life of Alabama and
24	engage in competitive integrated employment; and
25	WHEREAS, the State of Alabama has a responsibility to
26	ensure that individuals with disabilities have access to
27	employment opportunities in public service; now therefore,



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28	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
29	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That each state agency,
30	department, board, and commission is encouraged to hire and
31	advance individuals with disabilities.
32	(a) Each state agency, department, board, and
33	commission is encouraged to:
34	(1) Use best efforts with respect to the recruitment,
35	hiring, and advancement of individuals with disabilities;
36	and
37	(2) Review its hiring practices to identify any
38	barriers to employment of individuals with disabilities and
39	take appropriate action to eliminate any non-job-related
40	barriers to the integration of individuals with disabilities
41	into the workforce.
42	(b) Each state agency, department, board, and
43	commission shall be provided a copy of this resolution upon
