9	Rainsville Chief of Police, Michael Edmondson, and the

14	WHEREAS, Rainsville's ranking increased from eight
15	place to third place from last year; rankings are calculated
16	based on population and violent crime and property crime
17	statistics; in Rainsville, only 0.7 violent crimes and 2.3
18	property crimes were reported for every 1,000 residents; the
19	safest cities that made the list have an 84 percent lower
20	crime rate than the rest of the state; and
