4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, limitations of liability for
6	certain actions taken by equines are provided to their
7	owners.
8	This bill would provide limitations of liability
9	for certain actions taken by bovines to their owners.

13	TO BE ENTITLED
14	AN ACT
15	
16	Relating to animals; to provide limitations of
17	liability for certain actions of bovines to their owners.
18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
19	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
20	following terms have the following meanings, unless the
21	context requires otherwise:
22	(1) BOVINE. Any buffalo, bison, cattle, or oxen.
23	(2) BOVINE ACTIVITY. Any activity involving one or more
24	bovine, including, but not limited to, any of the following:
25	a. Grazing, herding, feeding, branding, milking, or
26	other activity that involves the care or maintenance of a
27	bovine.
28	b. A bovine auction or production sale.



- c. A bovine show, fair, or competition.
- d. Bovine training or teaching activities.
- e. Boarding a bovine.
- f. Riding, inspecting, or evaluating a bovine.
- 33 (3) BOVINE OWNER. Any person with ownership rights to a
- 34 bovine.
- 35 (4) INHERENT RISK OF A BOVINE ACTIVITY. A danger or
- 36 condition that is an integral part of a bovine activity,
- including, but not limited to, any of the following:
- 38 a. The propensity of a bovine to behave in ways that
- 39 may result in injury, loss, damage, or death to a person on or
- 40 around the bovine.
- b. The unpredictability of a bovine's reaction to
- 42 sounds, sudden movements, and unfamiliar objects, individuals,
- 43 and other animals.
- c. Certain hazards on a property, such as surface and
- 45 subsurface conditions.
- 46 d. Collisions with other bovines or nonmotorized
- 47 objects.
- 48 (5) PERSON. An individual, corporation, or any other
- 49 legal entity.
- 50 (b) (1) A bovine owner shall not be liable for any
- injury, loss, damage, or death of a person resulting from an
- 52 inherent risk of a bovine activity.
- 53 (2) Except as provided in subsection (c), no person
- 54 shall make any claim against, maintain an action against, or
- recover from a bovine owner for injury, loss, damage, or death
- of a person resulting from an inherent risk of a bovine



- 57 activity.
- (c) (1) Subsection (b) shall not be construed to prevent
- or limit the liability of a bovine owner if the owner does any
- of the following:
- a. Fails to post and maintain a warning sign pursuant
- 62 to subsection (d).
- b. Commits an act or omission that constitutes willful
- or wanton disregard for the safety of a person, and that act
- or omission causes the injury, loss, damage, or death of a
- 66 person.
- 67 c. Has actual knowledge of the dangerous propensity of
- 68 a particular bovine that is not open and obvious, does not
- 69 make the danger known to a person, and the danger proximately
- 70 causes injury, sickness, damage, or death to the person.
- 71 (2) Article 2 of Chapter 15 of Title 35, Code of
- 72 Alabama 1975, shall not apply to a bovine owner if injury,
- 73 loss, damage, or death of a person results from an inherent
- 74 risk of a bovine activity.
- 75 (d) (1) This section shall not apply unless a bovine
- 76 owner posts and maintains a sign that contains the warning
- 77 notice specified in subdivision (2). The sign shall be placed
- 78 in a clearly visible location on or near a stable, corral,
- fence, enclosure, or arena where the owner conducts bovine
- 80 activities. The warning notice shall appear in black letters,
- 81 with each letter being a minimum of one inch in height.
- 82 (2) The sign described in subdivision (1) shall contain
- 83 the following warning notice:
- 84 "WARNING



Under Alabama Law, a bovine owner is not liable for
any injury, loss, damage, or death of a person
resulting from the inherent risks of bovine activities,
pursuant to this act."
Section 2. This act shall become effective on January
1, 2025.
