

4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, county and municipality
6	library boards are appointed by the respective
7	governing body of the county or municipality.
8	This bill would provide that library board
9	members shall serve at the pleasure of their respective
10	appointing authorities.
11	This bill would also make nonsubstantive,
12	technical revisions to update the existing code
13	language to current style.

17	TO BE ENTITLED
18	AN ACT

20	Relating to libraries; to amend Section 11-90-2, Code
21	of Alabama 1975; to further provide for the appointment of
22	county and municipal library boards; and to make
23	nonsubstantive, technical revisions to update the existing
24	code language to current style.
25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section 11-90-2, Code of Alabama 1975, is
27	amended to read as follows:
28	"\$11-90-2





29	(a) The government and supervision of such All
30	libraries shall be vested in created pursuant to this chapter
31	shall be supervised by a library board consisting of five
32	members who shall be appointed by the county commission or the
33	governing body of the municipality.
34	(b) Each library board member shall be appointed by the
35	governing body of the county or municipality that established
36	the library.
37	(c) Each library board member shall be appointed to a
38	four-year term and shall serve at the pleasure of their
39	respective appointing authority and may be removed at any time
40	by a majority vote of the appointing authority <mark>The terms of</mark>
41	membership on the library board, as first appointed, for one
42	member shall be for one year, for the second member shall be
43	for two years, for the third member shall be for three years,
44	and for the remaining two members the terms shall be for four
45	years. After the first term, all appointments shall be for
46	four years.
47	(d) The county commission or <u>respective</u> governing body
48	shall fill all vacancies including expired and unexpired
49	terms.
50	(e) Members of the library board shall serve without
51	compensation."
52	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
53	1, 2024.
