1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
4 existence and functioning of the Alabama Electronic Security
5 Board of Licensure until October 1, 2028.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
8 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama
9 Electronic Security Board of Licensure until October 1, 2028.

10 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Alabama
11 Electronic Security Board of Licensure, created and
12 functioning pursuant to Chapter 1A of Title 34, Code of
13 Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code sections are
14 expressly preserved.

15 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
16 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
17 Sections 1 and 2.

18 Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,
19 2024.
