4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, termination dates are
6	established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies
7	are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset
8	Committee. After the review process is completed, the
9	committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies
10	to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which
11	either continue, terminate, or continue with
12	modification each agency reviewed.
13	This bill would provide for the continuance of
14	the Alabama Board of Funeral Services until October 1,
15	2028.

19	TO BE ENTITLED
20	AN ACT

22	Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
23	existence and functioning of the Alabama Board of Funeral
24	Services until October 1, 2028.
25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
27	Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama
28	Board of Funeral Services until October 1, 2028.

SB120 INTRODUCED



Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Alabama 29 Board of Funeral Services, created and functioning pursuant to 30 31 Chapter 13 of Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued, 32 and those code sections are expressly preserved. Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the 33 34 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in Sections 1 and 2. 35 36 Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1, 37 2024.
