3 SYNOPSIS:

4 Under existing law, termination dates are 5 established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies 6 are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset 7 Committee. After the review process is completed, the 8 committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies 9 to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with 10 11 modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the Alabama Board of Examiners in Counseling until October 1, 2026.
