4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, termination dates are
6	established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies
7	are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset
8	Committee. After the review process is completed, the
9	committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies
10	to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which
11	either continue, terminate, or continue with
12	modification each agency reviewed.
13	This bill would provide for the continuance of
14	the Board of Examiners of Assisted Living
15	Administrators until October 1, 2026.

25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
27	Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of
28	Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators until October 1,

30 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Board of Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators, created and 31 32 functioning pursuant to Chapter 2A of Title 34, Code of 33 Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code sections are 34 expressly preserved. Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the 35 36 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in Sections 1 and 2. 37 Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1, 38 39 2024.
