5	Under existing law, limitations of liability for
6	certain actions taken by equines are provided to their
7	owners.
8	This bill would provide limitations of liability
9	for certain actions taken by bovines to their owners.

16	Relating to animals; to provide limitations of
17	liability for certain actions of bovines to their owners.
18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
19	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
20	following terms have the following meanings, unless the
21	context requires otherwise:
22	(1) BOVINE. Any buffalo, bison, cattle, or oxen.
23	(2) BOVINE ACTIVITY. Any activity involving one or more
24	bovine, including, but not limited to, any of the following:
25	a. Grazing, herding, feeding, branding, milking, or
26	other activity that involves the care or maintenance of a
27	bovine.
28	b. A bovine auction or production sale.

29 c. A bovine show, fair, or competition. 30 d. Bovine training or teaching activities. 31 e. Boarding a bovine. 32 f. Riding, inspecting, or evaluating a bovine. 33 (3) BOVINE OWNER. Any person with ownership rights to a 34 bovine. 35 (4) INHERENT RISK OF A BOVINE ACTIVITY. A danger or 36 condition that is an integral part of a bovine activity, including, but not limited to, any of the following: 37 a. The propensity of a bovine to behave in ways that 38 39 may result in injury, loss, damage, or death to a person on or around the bovine. 40 41 b. The unpredictability of a bovine's reaction to 42 sounds, sudden movements, and unfamiliar objects, individuals, 43 and other animals. c. Certain hazards on the property, such as surface and 44 45 subsurface conditions. 46 d. Collisions with other bovines or objects. 47 (5) PERSON. An individual, corporation, or any other 48 legal entity. 49 (b) (1) A bovine owner shall not be liable for any 50 injury, loss, damage, or death of a person resulting from an 51 inherent risk of a bovine activity. 52 (2) Except as provided in subsection (c), no person 53 shall make any claim against, maintain an action against, or recover from a bovine owner for injury, loss, damage, or death 54 of a person resulting from an inherent risk of a bovine 55

57 (c)(1) Subsection (b) shall not be construed to prevent 58 or limit the liability of a bovine owner if the owner does 59 either of the following:

a. Fails to post and maintain warning signs pursuant tosubsection (d).

b. Commits an act or omission that constitutes willful
or wanton disregard for the safety of a person, and that act
or omission causes the injury, loss, damage, or death of a
person.

66 (2) Article 2 of Chapter 15 of Title 35, Code of
67 Alabama 1975, shall not apply to a bovine owner if injury,
68 loss, damage, or death of a person results from an inherent
69 risk of a bovine activity.

(d) (1) A bovine owner shall post and maintain signs that contain the warning notice specified in subdivision (2). A sign shall be placed in a clearly visible location on or near a stable, corral, fence, enclosure, or arena where the owner conducts bovine activities. The warning notice shall appear in black letters, with each letter being a minimum of one inch in height.

77 (2) The signs described in subdivision (1) shall78 contain the following warning notice:

WARNING

80 Under Alabama Law, a bovine owner is not liable for
81 any injury, loss, damage, or death of a person
82 resulting from the inherent risks of bovine activities,
83 pursuant to this act."

84 Section 2. This act shall become effective on January
