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4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, a nonprofit organization is
6	not authorized to offer health benefits to its members
7	and their families under a law that specifies that the
8	organization is not an insurer or in the business of
9	insurance.
10	This bill would authorize a nonprofit
11	agricultural organization to offer health benefits to
12	its members and their families. The bill would specify
13	that the nonprofit agricultural organization would not
14	be engaged in the business of health insurance.
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16	A BILL
17	TO BE ENACTED
18	AN ACT
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20	Relating to health benefits offered by a nonprofit
21	organization; to authorize a nonprofit agricultural
22	organization to offer health benefits to its members and their
23	families under certain conditions; and to specify that the
24	nonprofit agricultural organization would not be engaged in
25	the business of health insurance.
26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
27	Section 1. DEFINITIONS. For purposes of this act, the
28	following words have the following meanings:

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29	(1) NONPROFIT AGRICULTURAL ORGANIZATION. An
30	organization that meets all of the following:
31	a. Is exempt from federal income taxation under Section
32	501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as an organization
33	described by Section 501(c)(5).
34	b. Is domiciled in this state.
35	c. Was in existence prior to 1940.
36	d. Is composed of members who are residents of at least
37	98 percent of the counties in this state.
38	e. Collects annual dues from its members.
39	f. Was created to promote and develop the most
40	profitable and desirable system of agriculture and the most
41	wholesome and satisfactory conditions of rural life in
42	accordance with its articles of organization and bylaws.
43	(2) NONPROFIT AGRICULTURAL ORGANIZATION HEALTH
44	BENEFITS. Health benefits that meet all of the following
45	conditions:
46	a. Are sponsored by a nonprofit agricultural
47	organization or an affiliate of the organization.
48	b. Are offered only to either of the following:
49	1. Members of the nonprofit agricultural organization.
50	2. Family members of members of the nonprofit
51	agricultural organization.
52	c. Are not provided through an insurance policy or
53	other product the offering or issuance of which is regulated
54	as the business of insurance in this state.
55	d. Are deemed by the nonprofit agricultural
56	organization to be important in assisting its members to live



57 long and productive lives.

58 Section 2. A nonprofit agricultural organization or an 59 affiliate of the organization may offer in this state 60 nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits.

61 Section 3.(a) A nonprofit agricultural organization 62 that offers nonprofit agricultural organization health 63 benefits shall provide to an individual applying for nonprofit 64 agricultural organization health benefits written notice that 65 the benefits are not provided through an insurance policy or 66 other product the offering or issuance of which is regulated 67 as the business of insurance in this state.

(b) An individual shall be required to sign and return to the nonprofit agricultural organization the notice described by subsection (a) before the individual may enroll in nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits. The nonprofit agricultural organization shall do both of the following:

(1) Maintain a copy of the signed written notice for the duration of the term during which the nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits are provided to the individual.

78 (2) At the request of the individual, provide a copy of79 the written notice to the individual.

Section 4. Notwithstanding any provision of Title 27 or Article 6 of Chapter 20 of Title 10A of the Code of Alabama 1975, for the purposes of offering nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits, a nonprofit agricultural organization that acts in accordance with this act is not a

85 health insurer and is not engaging in the business of health 86 insurance in this state.

Section 5. A nonprofit agricultural organization that 87 88 offers nonprofit agricultural organization health benefits 89 under this act may contract with an entity or entities 90 authorized to engage in the business of insurance in this 91 state that is not under common control with the nonprofit 92 agricultural organization in order to transfer to the entity 93 or entities all or a portion of the organization's risks arising from nonprofit agricultural organization health 94 95 benefits offered under this act.

96 Section 6. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 97 with this act are repealed.

98 Section 7. This act shall become effective June 1,99 2024.
