18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
19	Section 1. Section 13A-10-241, as created by Act
20	2023-493, 2023 Regular Session, Code of Alabama 1975, is

23	(a) A person commits the crime of making a terrorist
24	threat in the first degree when he or she, based on an
25	objective evaluation, credibly threatens to commit a crime of
26	violence against a person or to damage any property by use of
27	a bomb, explosive, weapon of mass destruction, firearm, deadly
28	weapon, or other mechanism and any of the following occurs:

- 29 (1) The threat causes the evacuation of any real
- 30 property.
- 31 (2) The threat causes the disruption of a school,
- 32 church, or government activity.
- 33 (3) The threat is with intent to retaliate against the
- 34 victim because of his or her involvement or participation as
- 35 any of the following:
- a. A witness or party in any judicial or administrative
- 37 proceeding.
- 38 b. A person who produced records, documents, or other
- 39 objects in a judicial or administrative proceeding.
- c. A person who provided to a law enforcement officer,
- 41 adult or juvenile probation officer, prosecuting attorney, or
- 42 judge any information relating to the commission or possible
- 43 commission of an offense under the laws of this state, of the
- 44 United States, or a violation of conditions of bail, pretrial
- 45 release, probation, or parole.
- 46 (4) The threat is made against an elected public
- 47 official or his or her staff.
- 48 (b) The crime of making a terrorist threat in the first
- 49 degree is a Class C felony.
- 50 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose
- or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of
- 52 local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements
- and application under Section 111.05 of the Constitution of
- Alabama of 2022, because the bill defines a new crime or
- amends the definition of an existing crime.
- Section 3. This act shall become effective on October
