12	Section 1. (a) For the period commencing October 1,
13	2024, and ending September 30, 2029, unless extended by an act
14	of the Legislature, the gross proceeds from the sale of honey
15	bees, including their inputs and byproducts, are exempt from
16	the state sales and use tax as provided for in Section
17	40-23-2, Code of Alabama 1975.
18	(b) For purposes of this section, the term "honeybee
19	byproducts" means the various substances and materials
20	produced by honeybees during their life cycle and hive
21	activities, including, but not limited to, honey, propolis,
22	royal jelly, beeswax, honeycombs, bee venom, and honeybee
23	pollen.
24	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
25	1, 2024.
