14	Relating to taxation; to provide an exemption from the
15	state sales and use tax for honeybees and their byproducts.
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
17	Section 1.(a) The gross proceeds from the sale of honey
18	bees, including their inputs and byproducts, are exempt from
19	the state sales and use tax as provided for in Section
20	40-23-2, Code of Alabama 1975.
21	(b) For purposes of this section, the term "honeybee
22	byproducts" means the various substances and materials
23	produced by honeybees during their life cycle and hive
24	activities, including, but not limited to, honey, propolis,
25	royal jelly, beeswax, honeycombs, bee venom, and honeybee
26	pollen.
27	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
