4	SJR CELEBRATING AND REMEMBERING THE LIFE OF WILLIAM
5	DUDLEY MELTON.

7	WHEREAS, it is with heavy hearts that we recognize
8	the passing of William Dudley Melton of Evergreen, Alabama,
9	whose departure on October 10, 2023, leaves a legacy of
10	unwavering commitment to his family, community, and
11	profession; and
12	WHEREAS, Mr. Melton, affectionately known as Billy,
13	was born in 1943 to loving parents, Thomas Plowden Melton,
14	Jr. and Eulynne Brantley Melton; he was a descendant of the
15	earliest pioneer families who settled western Butler and
16	eastern Wilcox Counties in the community of Friendship,
17	which later became Pine Apple, Alabama; he was a lifelong
18	hobby historian and served as Director of the Alabama
19	Historical Society, as well as a member of the boards of the
20	Wilcox County Historical Society, the Butler County
21	Historical and Genealogical Society, the Alabama Heritage
22	Foundation, Sons of the American Revolution, Sons of
23	Confederate Veterans, the Alabama Genealogical Society, and
24	First Families of Alabama; and
25	WHEREAS, as an Evergreen High School student, Class
26	of 1961, Billy lettered in three sports and was designated
27	an All-State football player; he was an honor student,

29	Alabama Beta Clubs, and Lieutenant Governor of Boy's State
30	and Attorney General of Boy's Nation, both of which are
31	programs of The American Legion; and
32	WHEREAS, Mr. Melton was awarded a football
33	scholarship from Auburn University and played on the 1961
34	freshman team; he was a member of Squires, a men's sophomore
35	honor fraternity, and the Nu Chapter of the Kappa Alpha
36	Order; he was a life member of the Auburn Alumni Association
37	following his graduation in 1964; he entered The University
38	of Alabama School of Law in 1963, where he served as
39	President of the student bar association; he graduated in
40	1966 and was admitted to the Alabama State Bar that same
41	year; he accepted a position in the Office of the Attorney
42	General; and
43	WHEREAS, also in 1966, Billy Melton won the
44	Democratic Primary and was elected to Place 2 of District 34
45	in the Alabama House of Representatives; he served on the
46	House Judiciary and Inter-Governmental Committees; he did
47	not seek re-election and was nominated by the State
48	Democratic Committee to fill a vacancy in the Alabama
49	Senate, District 19, in 1973; he served on the Senate
50	Judiciary and Insurance Committees; and he supported the
51	Judicial Article; after fulfilling his term, he returned to
52	the courtroom, became an AV Bar Register lawyer by 39 years
53	of age, and served as a trial lawyer for nearly 50 years;

55	WHEREAS, Mr. Melton served on numerous professional
56	and community boards of directors, including leadership

58	Vice President, Member, and Chairman, Alabama Board of
59	Disciplinary Appeals; he also made an impact through his
60	service to Alabama's judicial system; he served as Bar
61	Commissioner, 35th Judicial Circuit, from 1986-1996, and as
62	a Judge on the Alabama Court of the Judiciary for many
63	years; along with being licensed to practice in the State of
64	Alabama, he was licensed in the U.S. Supreme Court, the U.S.
65	Court of Appeals Fifth and Eleventh Circuits, and the Poarch
66	Band of Creek Indians Tribal Court; and
67	WHEREAS, Mr. Melton continued to support the students
68	and faculty of The University of Alabama School of Law
69	throughout his life; he received the 2007 Sam W. Pipes
70	Farrah Law Alumni Society Award; served as Vice Chairman and
71	Chairman of the Farrah Law Society; and served as a member
72	of the Board of Directors, Secretary, Vice President, and
73	President of The University of Alabama School of Law
74	Foundation; and
75	WHEREAS, Billy Melton cherished his family and the
76	Lord above all else; he was a devoted member of the
77	Evergreen Baptist Church where he taught Sunday School and
78	served as a Deacon; he generously gave of his time and
79	talent to co-author and edit "The History of The Evergreen
80	Baptist Church" having already authored "Uninsured Motorist
81	Coverage: A Significant Decision" in The Alabama Lawyer and
82	served on the editorial boards of Alabama Trial Lawyers
83	Journal and The Alabama Lawver: now therefore.
