4 SJR___ COMMENDING THE ALABAMA WRITERS' FORUM FOR LITERARY 5 CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE STATE OF ALABAMA AND PROMOTING THE 6 WORKS OF PAST AND CONTEMPORARY ALABAMA AUTHORS AND POETS.

8 WHEREAS, the Alabama Writers' Forum was founded in 9 1993 by acclaimed poet Jeanie Thompson with mentorship from 10 the Alabama State Council on the Arts; the Alabama Writers' Forum serves as our state's landmark, statewide nonprofit 11 working to cultivate the rich literary culture of Alabama; 12 13 its programs include Writing Our Stories, a nationally recognized creative writing program for justice-involved 14 15 youth; its Alabama High School Literacy Arts Awards program recognizing young writers, their teachers, and schools, 16 17 awarding scholarships for achievement in a wide variety of 18 literary arts; and

19 WHEREAS, the Forum supports the Alabama Writers Hall 20 of Fame in partnership with the Alabama Center for the Book 21 at The University of Alabama; the website provides robust 22 and up-to-date content for literary news, reviews,

23 resources, and events; and

24 WHEREAS, its online Alabama Authors Directory 25 provides information about writers and their works and 26 awards, as well as their availability for readings, 27 workshops, and other programs; and

28 WHEREAS, the Alabama Writers' Forum works with a wide

29 network of state and national partnerships to support, 30 advocate, and promote writers and reading throughout the state; a partnership program of the Alabama State Council on 31 32 the Arts, the Forum has been funded by national 33 organizations, including the National Endowment for the Arts and LitNet, as well as by state agencies, corporate 34 35 sponsors, and individual and corporate members; and 36 WHEREAS, founded through a partnership between the

Alabama Writers' Forum and the Alabama Center for the Book, 37 38 the Alabama Writers Hall of Fame (AWHOF) has recognized Alabama writers whose accomplishments have earned them 39 40 national and international reputations in the literary arts; 41 AWHOF has inducted five classes of honorees; E.O. Wilson, 42 Fannie Flagg, Winston Groom, Margaret Walker, Harper Lee, 43 and Sonia Sanchez are among those recognized; these honorees 44 testify to the rich literary culture of our state; now 45 therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Alabama Writers' Forum is highly honored and commended, and this resolution is offered with heartiest appreciation and congratulations on current success and best wishes in all future endeavors.
